

The Dr. Dorothy E. Lee Endowment Fund for Nontraditional Women Students Grant Guidelines and Application

The purpose of this grant is to help women, 25 years of age or older, who are current Illinois State University students, to fund incidental expenses such as car repair, childcare, etc.

Each candidate for a Dr. Dorothy E. Lee Grant should meet the following qualifications:

A. Full or part time female undergraduate students, 25 years of age or older, who is enrolled in a degree program, or has been admitted as an adult learner with the intention to enroll in a degree program, at Illinois State University.

B. Submission of a grant request, which identifies the need for money for incidental expenses, such as for assistance with childcare, books and supplies, transportation, tutoring and the like. **Documentation is required with the grant application!**

Applications are accepted all year and will be awarded until the grant amount has expired.
